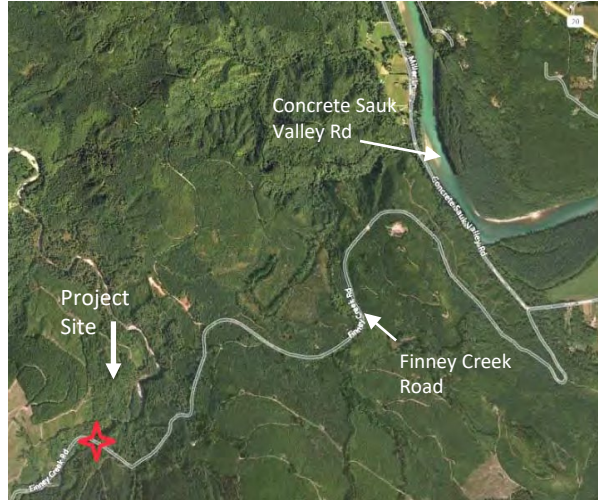




Upper Finney Creek Bridge (Seismic Retrofit) Finney Creek Road Reopens to Traffic on September 7, 2023

Project Description:	The project is located at Finney Creek Road at milepost 4.6 to 4.7. The existing Upper Finney Creek Bridge was built in 1952 with posted weight limits, which included the U80 logging truck. This restricted the capacity for logging trucks and equipment crossing the bridge. The project included retrofitting the existing columns, strengthening the deck, cap beams, girders, and footings to increase seismic performance.		
Status:	Construction Complete		
Traffic Impacts:	Finney Creek Road at the Upper Finney Creek Bridge has been closed for construction since the summer of 2022. The road has now been reopened at milepost 4.62 after the bridge was retrofitted to strengthen and increase the bridge's structural integrity and capacity to accommodate logging trucks and other heavy equipment. Completion of the project was delayed due to harsh weather, sub-optimal working conditions, and supply chain issues. The completion of this project now reopens the area to both logging and recreational use.
