




Revenue Sources – 5-year average






Revenue Sources – 2020






Trends – 65% Methodology Applied






Trends – Fare Box Revenue Vs. Road Fund Subsidy

Summary

- 2020 O&M expenditures
 - \$1,886,139 (under budget by 43%)
- 2020 revenue target shortfall
 - o **\$296,847**
- O&M expenditures (5-year average)
 - \circ \$2.4 million
- Road fund subsidy (5-year average)

 \$831,959
- Haul-outs increase costs by roughly \$1 million/year



Recommendations

- Since 2018, fare box revenue has not met the target
 - Fare methodology is problematic
- 2021 fare box revenue is not projected not meet target

2021 Fare Revenue Target	\$ 1,300,624
2021 Projected Fare Box Revenue	\$ <u>1,195,328</u>
Projected difference	\$ (105,296)

- A fare increase and other fare changes are recommended in 2021.
 - Rescind and replace methodology
 - o Streamline fare categories
 - o Standardize discounts
