May 28th Ferry Haul-Out Update

The Guemes Island ferry has passed dock and sea trials and officially arrived back in Anacortes last night. We have the incline test with the U.S. Coast Guard scheduled for tomorrow, Thursday May 29th. After the incline test has been successfully completed, we will send out our next notice to officially announce the date and time the vehicle ferry will return to service. It is possible we will need both tomorrow and Friday to finish the test, but we will keep you posted.

In the meantime, **please don't forget to purchase your ferry tickets on our app or on the [website](#) prior to arrival at the ferry terminal.** Both vehicle and passenger tickets are now available for purchase and purchasing ahead of time will allow you to bypass the ticket office at the terminal. If you have a dated punch card (regardless of the expiration date on the card), the expiration date has been extended to two weeks beyond the ferry's return to service date. Once we have that date, we will officially announce the last day we will accept dated punch cards for the ferry. Additionally, COVID Emergency Punch Cards and Convenience Cards (marked "no expiry") will continue to be valid for regular use through December 31, 2025. After that date, they will no longer be accepted.
