# Haul-out set for May 14 - June 12

The next scheduled haul-out of the Guemes Island Ferry will be Friday, May 14, through Saturday, June 12, 2021, at Nichols Brothers Boat Builders in Freeland. Note: The car ferry will be out of service during Memorial Day weekend, so please plan accordingly.

It's been more than two years since the M/V Guemes was last hauled out for maintenance. While the ferry system completed 99% of its scheduled runs in 2020, the vessel needs maintenance so it can continue to provide reliable service.

During the haul-out, Arrow Launch will provide passenger-only service, and Skagit Transit will provide shuttle service on Guemes Island.


### PASSENGER-ONLY FERRY SERVICE

The Strait Arrow will operate between the regular ferry docks in Anacortes and on Guemes Island. Due to COVID-19, the 49-passenger vessel will operate at reduced capacity of 25. The Strait Arrow will make extra sailings as needed. The Strait Arrow can carry bicycles and small motorcycles at the discretion of the Captain. Well-behaved leashed dogs are allowed on the vessel, but not inside the cabin.

### SKAGIT TRANSIT SHUTTLE SERVICE

Skagit Transit will provide call-in-based shuttle service for Guemes Island residents to meet the passenger ferry. Only one bus will operate on-island, and may not be able to meet all ferry arrivals and departures. Please plan ahead. The driver will do their best to accommodate.


