## **Project Description**

This project was designed to extend and rebuild a faulty livestock exclusion fence, remove invasive vegetation from the riparian zone, and replant with native trees and shrubs along Thunder Creek. The fence was 575 foot long fence was installed 100 feet from Thunder Creek and enclosed 0.95 acres from the horses on the property. Invasive removal was completed by Skagit County Public Works by mowing the existing blackberries. Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group installed the fencing and planted 350 native plants along 520 linear feet of Thunder Creek. Site maintenance will continue through 2014.

This project is adjacent to the Thunder Creek project completed in 2010.
