Project Description

Skagit County installed approximately 1,260 feet of livestock exclusion fencing to restrict access to horses on the property adjacent to the unnamed tributary to Cranberry Lake. This project involved removal of Himalayan blackberry and the planting of 311 native plants on 1.43 acres. The riparian area averaged 35-feet for most of the project site, extending to 125 feet on the northeastern property corner. This project also included the installation of the livestock crossing to reduce fecal inputs in the water while the horses were changing pastures.

This project was supplemented by an additional National Fish and Wildlife Foundation grant.
