Cover crop

About 650 acres planted in fall each year. Avg cost \$45 per acre for seed. Seed costs paid, installation by landowner. Perhaps also \$45 per acre cost to farmer to install. Has sidebars and needs to follow NRCS. Must terminate in spring.

Benefit – erosion is perhaps most significant. Helps keep sediment out of waterways so they don't Also waterfowl.

Haven't had enough funding to meet demand. This year can't necessarily use more. Need to have funding available sooner for planning

Cover crops helping absorb N from waterfowl which also helps WQ

Where does it fit within work plan? We are looking at specific areas within water area for WQ?
