## ARE YOU GOING TO MAKE TRIP?

H. L. Willis Urges Skagit County To Learn of Flood Control.

The trip to Tacoma next Friday and Saturday should be of interest to every man and woman in Skagit county. When in 1906 the whole volume of White River was turned into the Puyallup, trouble began for residents along the lower reaches of the Puyallup. In 1914 King and Pierce counties took up the job in earnest and in the next few years had the flood problem solved.

We in Skagit county are facing a similar but larger problem. For the past ten days the county has had an engineer from the U.S. Geological Survey at work on the upper Skagit near Concrete assembling data on the volume of last December's flood. The object is to determine how much watr came down upon us last December. for it is evident that we could make to adequate plans for taking care of any flood unless we knew about how much water was to be taken care of. Then this new data of our recent lood is secured, all the other data on he flow and flood of the Skagit Rivr will be assembled from their var-bus sources. The general plan then eems to be to place all this data in e hands of a competent engineer d ask him to submit a comprehenwe plan for the control of our river. it seems necessary this plan could submitted to consulting engineers their approval or rejection. When get this far it will be up to the ople of the county or the flooded ea to determine what next shall be me. Then we shall have an authoriive, comprehensive plan under hich not only we local people can ork but which we can present with ect to the state or the U.S. governent when we go to them for help. t let us never forget that we will no help worth while from any rce until we show that we are thy of some help by beginning to p ourselves.

It is just here in making ourselves more intelligent and interested in river problems that this trip to Tacoma is of value. We want to see what they have done there; not necessarily that that will be what we want to do, but that we may more intelligently criticize, adopt or reject our own plan when we get it. For if a plan is ever int over, it will be because we people of Skagit county are behind it.

Every man or woman in Skagit ounty who is interested in the confol of our Skagit river floods is not aly invited but urged to go with this kagit county delegation to Tacoma ext Friday, December 1. Arrange roups of four or five in your various mmunities, share up the expense ith the owner of the car, and leave ome in time to reach the court house Tacoma at four P. M. Friday, Dember 1. The court house can be easfound. It is about four or five ocks straight up the hill from the finished skeleton of the Scandinav-American Bank building. M. Mr. Roberts, chief engineer of e Puyallup project, will show the elegation the maps and pictures in office in the court house and exain the work. The next forenoon he all show them the work on the river ging upone side of the river probabas far as the city of Puyallup and ere crossing and coming down on e other side. If any one should fail get to the court house Friday afteron in time, he could join the party turday morning probably at about 30 at the Indian school bridge. This the bridge on the Pacific Highway er the Puyallup River just east of coma and will be the first step on inspection of the river Saturday ming.
