Dike District Information Given

A letter received by Norm Wallace from R. H. Schroder, secretary for Dike district 12 answers several questions uppermost in the minds of several Burlington residents and the letter is re-printed below through the courtesy of Mr. Wallace.

Dear Mr. Wallace:

On behalf of the City of Burlington and those interested, you have asked when the new dike which is to be built under the plans of Dike District No. 12, east and northeast of Burlington, will be built.

Our present difficulty arises from the fact that we have some trouble acquiring a small portion of the right-of-way but we expect this will be ironed out shortly. As soon as right-of-way is fully acquired, and weather conditions permit, we expect to proceed immediately. It would be costly to the taxpayers and foolish to attempt piece-meal construction. We have received and hope to continue to receive the support of the majority of interested parties.
