LAKE SHANNON MILL STARTS OPERATION AGAIN THIS WEEK

SHINGLES SHIPPED AFTER SHUTDOWN MAKES OPERATION AGAIN POSSIBLE - CREW NOW BACK ON JOBS.

The Lake Shannon Shingle mill, operated here by Miller & Foss, started operations again Monday of this week after a shutdown of over a month. The shingle market had forced the shutdown, but recently orders were received for enough shingle to empty the kilns at the mill.

The full crew is now back to work and the cook-house has been opened up under the supervision of Mr. And Mrs. Busey.

If present conditions continue the mill is expected to run most of the summer without shutting down again. At the least a month's run in virtually certain.
