SKAGIT RIVER STILL TOPS FOR STEELHEAD FISHING

The Skagit River still fed all streams in the state for steelhead last season. Although the catch for the entire state showed a decrease of 21 per cent from the 1959-60 season, a total of 117,750 fish were reported through the punch card returns.

The Skagit River produced 12,566 steelhead, according to the figures reported back by the sportsmen. Next highest stream was the Green River, which had a total of 8,448. Last season the Skagit showed a total of 18,568 fish caught.
