

Flood Control District O. K'd By Plan Council

Organization of a flood control district in Skagit county, embracing all the territory east of Swinomish channel, has the backing of the Skagit county planning council. The group, meeting in the office of Welts & Welts here last night, approved unanimously a motion to recommend the formation of a legally organized district. Senator W. J. Knutzen moved for approval and was seconded by Harold McFarlane.

The action will be reported here Thursday morning to a state commission which will come here for a public hearing on the flood control district plan.

The Skagit council approved projects submitted by the Hamilton grade school district, the Birdsvew grade school district, a project of dike district No. 8, and a drainage project, sponsored by the city of Burlington.

S. G. Mosier and C. F. Shrauger were named on a committee to investigate ways and means for obtaining funds for development of a new road that would tap the mineral resources of the county.
