

Allocate \$60,000 For Dike Repairs

WASHINGTON, March 16—(U.P.) The Corps of Army Engineers has allocated \$60,000 to repair four breaks in dikes along the Skagit River in Washington caused by recent floods, Rep. Henry M. Jackson, D., Wash., said today.

Jackson said he had asked the engineers to allocate money also for repairs of flood damage on the Snohomish, Stillaguamish and Nooksack Rivers.

He said it was roughly estimated that \$500,000 would be needed for repair work on all four rivers. A 50-50 division of the cost between the government and local agencies is being considered, he said.
