## SKAGIT RIVER UP 14 FEET

Rising rapidly, the Skagit river is fourteen and one-half feet higher to-day than it was at 9:30 last night. The Skagit began rising last night, due to warm winds of Thursday. Before it started to rise, the river was one-half foot below sea level; the lowest it has been this season. Boats on the river had difficulty in docking. The heavy rains of last night have had no effect thus far. It is not expected that there will be any flood danger.
