

Meeting Summary Skagit CFHMP Dike and Drainage Technical Committee

Committee Meeting Notes

Committee members introduced themselves, including any organization affiliation and title, background about their interest in flood planning, and hopes and desires for this effort.

The group reviewed documents in their notebooks focusing on Technical Committee Operating Rules and Procedures. They reviewed approaches for reaching consensus. The Group then discussed the organizational structure of the CFHMP process. The participants understood that while they would receive assignments from the Advisory Committee, they could provide input back to the Advisory Committee on additional efforts that might be important. It was understood that communications within the committee itself, with the other Technical Committees, and with the Advisory Committee would be critical to ultimate success.

The group briefly discussed various flood-related projects and activities that their districts are involved with, and raised questions about the Corp of Engineers GI study.

The Committee then agreed upon an agenda for its next meeting along with the date and time. It also posed the following items for further discussion at the next meeting:

• Mission Statement - A proposed mission statement was stated as follows: "To produce individual and aggregate flood control ideas and concepts and to bring forth to the Advisory Committee for considerations. In purpose, no idea will go unheard." Small projects need to be on the radar
