Committee Meeting Notes

Committee members introduced themselves, including any organization affiliation and title, background about their interest in flood planning, and hopes and desires for this effort.

The group reviewed documents in their notebooks focusing on Technical Committee Operating Rules and Procedures. They reviewed approaches for reaching consensus. The Group then discussed the organizational structure of the CFHMP process. The participants understood that while they would receive assignments from the Advisory Committee, they could provide input to the Advisory Committee on additional efforts that might be important. It was understood that communications within the committee itself, with the other Technical Committees, and with the Advisory Committee, would be critical to ultimate success. Review of Procedures:

- Roger Ridgway gave a review of the technical committee operating rules and procedures as illustrated in the member notebooks that were distributed.

- What studies have been done in the GI?
- Concern about the time commitment when things are still unclear
