

MEETING SUMMARY

Advisory Committee Meeting #12
Flood Control Zone District
June 15, 2009 from 2:30 pm - 5:30 pm

Location

Skagit County Commissioner's Hearing Room
1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, WA

Meeting Purpose - For the Advisory Committee (AC) members to conduct normal business and:

1. *To understand the process for and discuss producing a draft CFHMP*
2. *To consider AC efforts to-date and consider any recommendations on the process/logistics to the Board of Supervisors*
3. *To consider and prepare for a presentation on AC progress to the Board of Supervisors*
4. *Determine next steps and schedule, including Technical Committee assignments, if any.*
5. *Continue the process of a local screening of Skagit GI Measures, and any local projects using screening and fatal flaw criteria, in order to provide input for the CFHMP and to the Army Corps for their consideration as they screen the measures.*
6. *Consideration and initial decision making recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and Army Corps.*
7. *Consideration of what measures/projects will be necessary and what package/s make sense to consider*

3. Discussion on the logistics of flood control planning, including: The CFHMP process/timeline. AC membership. Planning and project funding. Presenting CFHMP progress report to the public and Board of County Commissioners, etc.

1. For all Technical Committees, provide comments on the potential local project, "Emergency Overflow Spillway." For information on this project, along with comments from the Advisory Committee's April 20th meeting see attachment #5.
2. For the ETC, the Advisory Committee requests that they reevaluate their proposed "Habitat Restoration Projects in the Upper Basin Tributaries" and make a decision on whether they want this to be considered as a local project and if so to better define the concept, and to specifically list upper basin projects and details where this might be practical.
