- Dave Towne walked the group through an overland flow "map" he provided marked with a flow path that intersects with Joe Leary slough. (attached)
- Group emphasized need to get Hydrology correct so measures can be evaluated
- Committee remains focused on:
 - O Determining maximum flow that can be safely conveyed through bridge corridor and existing levee alignments and
 - O Where the excess 100-year flow will go and how often
 - Concerned that current Corps H and H raises question on ability to manage flood risk and protect public health and safety

- Does not adversely effect Public Safety and existing level of risk management
- Mapping effort adequate to evaluate existing conditions and compare effectiveness of measures.
- Evaluated for cost efficient structural maintenance
- Need to get Nookachamps storage right
 - o Evaluate delaying filling Nookachamps basin not increasing WSE of current storage
