

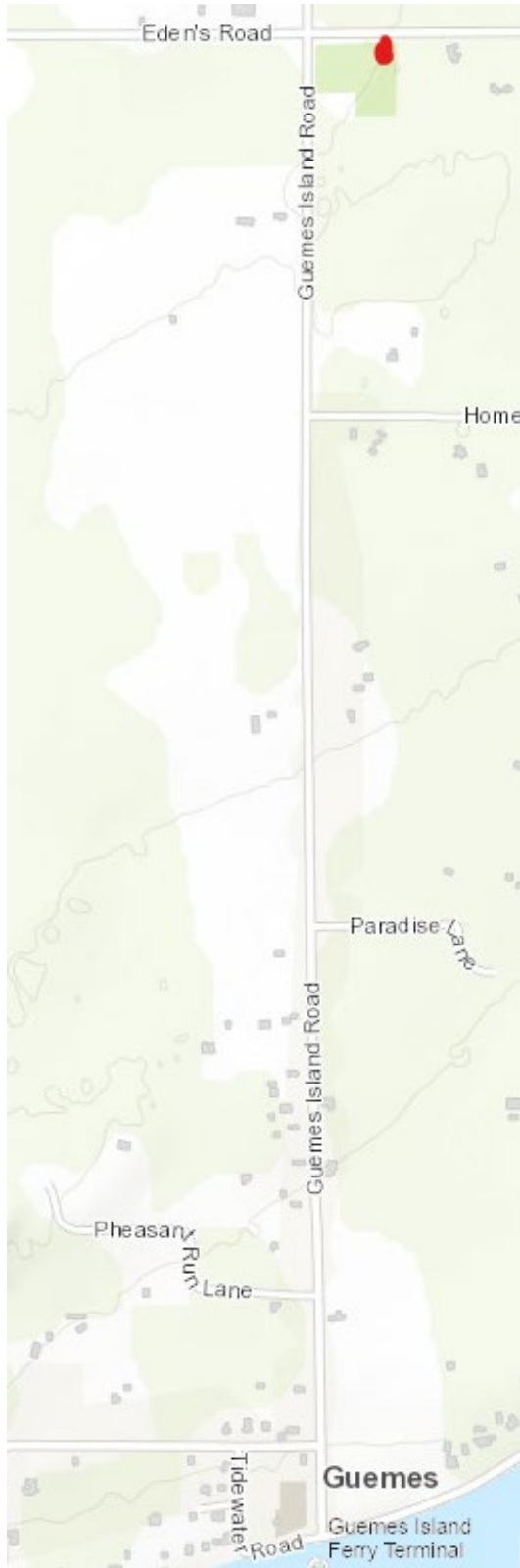
AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 TO THE BID DOCUMENTSAmendment Date: **September 15, 2026****SKAGIT COUNTY GUEMES ISLAND ROAD TRAIL**

A. This Amendment shall be considered part of the bid documents for the above-mentioned project as though it had been issued at the same time and shall be incorporated integrally therewith. Where provisions of the following supplementary data differ from those of the original bid documents, this Amendment shall govern and take precedence.

B. Bidders are hereby notified that they shall annotate receipt of this amendment in the bid proposal form and make any necessary adjustments in their estimates as a result of this Amendment. It will be construed that each bidder's proposal is submitted with full knowledge of all modifications and supplemental data specified herein.

Except as described below, the original bid document remains unchanged. The bid documents are modified and/or clarified, as follows:

1. **Amended Bid Form**. See attached with corrected base bid scope and completion date.
2. **Acceptable gravel size**. Based on seasonal availability of 3/8-minus, 5/8-minus gravel can be substituted for the trail base.
3. **ROW boundary**. No additional markers will be installed, however Sheets C2.1 – C2.4 include multiple points along the road with distance from Back of Curb to west edge of the trail.
4. **LDA permit**. Inspections for 1) Temporary Erosion and Sediment Control, 2) Dispersion, 3) Site Stabilization, and 4) Final Inspection must be scheduled via the County Parks Department. The design team calculated export at 85 CY, and more than 100 CY will trigger a review.
5. **Hedges on private property**. No brush cutting or hedge trimming will be performed by the County. Contractor will need to cut and haul shrubbery in future path area. Care must be given to maintain health of privacy bushes at 7753 Guemes Island Road. The trail may be less than 4' wide as necessary in this location to protect the hedge.
6. **Excavated material**. Excavation must comply with Skagit County Code Chapter [14.30](#), and the. Name and address of disposal location must be provided to the County as a requirement for the LDA permit. Destination location cannot be within established critical areas and will require a floodplain permit if in a floodplain.
7. **Equipment / Materials Staging area**. The gravel parking lot northwest of ferry landing on Guemes Island is highly utilized and not available for equipment or materials staging. The Parks Department can provide staging and materials storage area in the Schoolhouse Park parking lot off Eden's Road, located 1.5 mi north of the ferry landing.
