FRC is a voluntary therapeutic court program for parents of children involved in the dependency court process.

It provides parents with tools and supports to stabilize and maintain a lifestyle free from substance use while creating healthy family relationships.

REUNIFICATION OF FAMILIES

The goal of the court is to reunify families. This requires dedication to your recovery, hard work, and commitment to your family.



AM I ELIGIBLE?

To qualify for FRC you must:

Be 18 years of age or older

Have an active dependency case

Be willing to engage in a substance use evaluation and follow all treatment recommendations



WHAT TO EXPECT IN FRC:

Structure

You will provide random UAs, attend weekly process group, and find your sober community.

Support

Rental assistance, child care, and help with education and work expenses are available to all FRC participants.

Accountability

Positive behaviors are rewarded with incentives such as gift cards, movie tickets, recognition, and more.




Why should I participate in Family Recovery Court?

In Family Recovery Court, you will be supported by a team of professionals who are focused on your success.

You will be provided with services and have regular accountability and input from providers and the court to keep you on track.

FRC Families are 14% more likely to reunify and 12% more likely to stay together*.
