

TELEPHONIC APPOINTMENTS WITH FACILITATOR

- Call Clerk's Office (360)416-1800 or Court Administration (360) 416-1200 to set up appointment
- Download Disclaimer from Superior Court's website and print.
- Follow instructions to pay \$20.00 for appointment fee and put confirmation number on Disclaimer.

PAYMENTS

- If you do not know your case number, you can find it at: www.courts.wa.gov.
- If you have not yet filed a case and do not have a case number, use all zeros when asked to provide a case number.

Customer instructions for paying for Court Facilitator appointments using NCourt.

1. Log on to <https://www.skagitcounty.net/Departments/Clerk/ncourt.htm>
2. Click on the type of payment you wish to make.
3. For facilitator appointments, use the "copies" option; enter your case # or 00-0-00000-0 if you don't have one. Enter Facilitator appointment – mm/dd & time (date and time of your appointment) in the Note field. The amount is \$20 per ½ hour appointment – if you are pre-paying for a 1 hour appointment, you must pay \$40.
4. After entering your case number, optional note, and amount of payment, click Save.
5. Review your transaction list – select Continue
6. Review the terms & conditions. Select "I Agree" to move to the next screen or "I Decline" to terminate the transaction.
7. Complete the payment information screen & click Submit Payment.

If you prefer to call nCOURT, the number is 1-877-793-8935. Make sure to **add the confirmation number to the bottom of the Disclaimer form.**
