

2027 Skagit County Public Health Schedule of Charges

Effective January 1, 2027

Public Health is proposing updates to its fee schedule to more closely align fees with the cost of providing services and support the long-term sustainability of fee-supported programs. The Environmental Health services identified for increased fees to move toward better alignment with the cost of providing services include:

- Retail Food Safety permitting and inspections
- On-Site Sewage
- Drinking Water permitting
- *Hourly rates for miscellaneous Environmental Health services

*Hourly Rate: Some fees are based on the time required to provide a service. These fees may also change when the Environmental Health hourly rate is updated. The current hourly rate is \$195 per hour.

The fees established in this schedule of charges shall be automatically adjusted annually, effective January 1, by 4.65%, rounded to the nearest dollar, to account for inflationary increases in the cost of providing services. The Board of Health may, however, adopt a revised schedule of charges in lieu of the automatic adjustment when necessary to more accurately reflect the actual costs of providing services.
